



THE MENTORSHIP PROGRAM ON RESEARCH IN GLOBAL ADOLESCENT HEALTH

The IAAH YPN will launch a mentorship program from July through September 2021. The focus is on dissemination of adolescent health research. The program will consist of four virtual webinars (open to the public) as well as four small-group mentorship sessions (application only, limited to 10 participants).

The objectives for this mentorship program

The IAAH YPN mentorship program is designed for young professionals interested in global adolescent health. This program is open to a broad multidisciplinary team and across a diverse global community in adolescent health. The main objectives include:

1. To facilitate a short-term mentorship program with expert professionals within adolescent health.
2. To provide further knowledge into current research relevant to adolescent health.
3. To provide an understanding of global adolescent health care policies and strategies.
4. To increase knowledge of existing global health organizations and networks.
5. To facilitate a platform to present research projects to an international platform.

- Participants must commit to attending all mentorship sessions
- Participants must commit to presenting their research at the final session

Young Professionals Network (YPN)

The International Association for Adolescent Health (IAAH) Young Professional Network (YPN) is a community of students, trainees, and early career professionals (including health care providers, researchers, public health practitioners, advocates, scientists, social workers, pharmacists) who are interested in improving the health of adolescents locally, nationally, and globally. The IAAH YPN provides a forum for members to share training opportunities in adolescent health and supports networking, mentorship, and leadership development for trainees and early career professionals.

What is mentorship?

Mentorship in health care guides health career professionals who aspire to acquire new skills, information and further insight into their current field of interest. Mentorship typically involves one-to-one meetings between a mentor and mentee. The purpose of mentorship is to build confidence and provide guidance to the professional career development of the mentee.

What is flash mentoring?

Flash mentoring is one-time or short-term mentoring and is tailored to a specific group of like-minded mentees. It is centered around one-time meetings to provide knowledge or specific skills and to develop career and career mapping by building networks.

What are the benefits of flash mentorship?

- Networking with trained professionals within the adolescent health field
- Benefit from the shared experience and expertise of your mentor
- Guidance on career mapping and continual professional development
- Networking with international health care professionals of the IAAH and IAAH YPN

With a focus on research, our inaugural mentorship program aims to facilitate leadership and career development in global adolescent health.

From July to September, 10 emerging early career researchers will be mentored by world experts across four sessions to:

- Learn methods to effectively disseminate your research ideas
- Critically review and refine your research idea
- Present your preliminary research to leading multi-disciplinary leaders and peer researchers in small groups with an opportunity to present at the IAAH 2021 World Congress on Adolescent Health
